

Summer at Emerson Frequently Asked Questions

If my child does not attend Emerson School, can s/he attend Summer at Emerson?

Of course! In fact, almost 70% of our campers are not Emerson students.

If I choose an AM and PM camp, what does my child do between 12:00 and 1:00?

A period of supervised lunch and recess will be provided at no additional charge to campers enrolled in morning and afternoon camp.

I've chosen the camps my child is interested in; now what?

Complete both sides of the registration form and mail it in with a check for the deposit (\$25 per half-day camp) to: Summer at Emerson, 5425 Scio Church Road, Ann Arbor, MI 48015

How much do the camps cost?

Each half-day camp costs \$110. Some camps require a materials fee, which will be included in the camp's description in the brochure. The total fee for each half-day camp is on the registration form.

What time does the camp run?

AM camp runs from 9:00 am – 12:00 pm. PM camp runs from 1:00 pm – 4:00 pm.

Is before/after camp childcare available?

Yes! Before camp childcare is available from 8:00 am – 9:00 am and after camp childcare is available from 4:00 pm – 6:00 pm. Both are available on a drop-in basis at a rate of \$6 per hour.

What kind of paperwork is necessary?

Once you fill out both sides of the registration form, you are all set with paperwork for the entire summer! All of the health paperwork we need is on the back of the form.

What if my child needs medicine while at camp?

That is no problem; all we need is a form signed by a parent and the prescribing physician along with the medication in the original container. Medication forms can be obtained by contacting the Summer Program office at 734-665-4942 ext 101 or emailing summer@emerson-school.org.

What do we do when we first arrive at camp on Monday?

When you enter Summer at Emerson, you'll sign your child in under the name of the camp in which your child is enrolled. You'll receive a name tag with your child's name, camp names and room numbers. You'll also grab a locker tag to place on a locker of your child's choice, to be used all week.

Where can my child keep his or her things during camp?

Each child will choose a locker on Monday morning to be used for the entire week.

What goes on during Waterfest?

Every Friday from 3:00 pm – 4:00 pm, Waterfest occurs on the playground. Wet and wild games take place, including sponge dive, water balloon toss and many more favorites! As we transform the slide into a water slide and pair it with a slip and slide, we are all sure to have a great time! Please send a bathing suit, towel, and shoes that can get wet for your camper on Fridays!

Is Summer at Emerson a nut-free camp?

No, our summer camp is not nut-free; however, there is a nut-free table available at lunch daily. Children with allergies will have alternative options for snack if necessary. We will make all accommodations possible to make everyone comfortable and safe this summer.
