Spring Break Camp at Emerson School

Welcome!

We are excited to offer a full week of camp during Spring Break at Emerson School for the second year in a row! Camp is open to children who are currently enrolled in grades K-8 during the 2016-2017 school year, regardless of school attended. Morning camps run from 9am-12pm and afternoon camps from 1-4pm.

Register online through our summer camp portal at Emerson-School.org/Summer; payment in full is required at registration and refunds will only be considered for medical circumstances. Emerson School reserves the right to cancel a camp if minimum enrollment is not met.

Snacks are served once during morning camp and once during afternoon camp daily along with an outside recess break. Full-day campers must bring their own lunch to eat between 12-12:30pm and we'll head outside for supervised recess from 12:30-1pm. Please be sure to note online if your child has any allergies, medically-necessary dietary restrictions, or needs to take medication while at camp.

Drop-Off and Pick-Up: Electronic Sign In and Out with PIN

Each day a parent/guardian must walk each camper inside and sign in and out on our iPads with a personalized identification number (PIN). This number will be emailed out to all parents on Friday, March 31st and will include a PIN for each adult that is authorized to pick up your child. Please do not share your PIN with anyone and if you need to add another person, email the Summer Director at summer@emerson-school.org.

Before and After Camp Child Care

Child care is available before and after camp on a drop-in basis each day. Before camp child care runs from 8-9am for \$6/day. After camp child care runs from 4-6pm for \$6/hour. There is a strict \$4/minute per child late fee for all campers picked up after 6pm. Child care charges are billed to your account on April 10th and sent via email, with payment due June 1st. Note: if your child arrives before 8:50am or is picked up after 4:10pm, you will be charged for child care.

Photography

Your child's photograph may be taken during camp and used in publications, social media promotions or advertisements. It is our policy not to publish children's names with their photos. Please contact the Summer Program Director in writing prior to your child attending camp if you do not want your child photographed.

Electronics

Campers should not bring electronics with them to camp. Video games, laptops, cell phones, and cameras are not allowed at camp.
