Off the Wall Art! - Grades K-3 Only 4 spaces left!

Let's have some *Off the Wall* fun! We'll create interesting sculptures and hanging kinetic art that are anything but flat! Sumo Battles will then take place in a 4ft. diameter ring with the goal of knocking your opponent out of the ring as quickly and efficiently as possible. Strategy is a must, and students will repeatedly try new ideas in order to test and refine their robot before they begin the official battle rounds, learning as they go.
