# Halloween Information and Timeline for Parents

## COSTUMES

- K-8 students (and parents if they choose) should arrive before school Wednesday morning in full costume.
- Make sure costumes are appropriate, comply with the Emerson dress-code, and do not include weapons of any kind (if an item like a lightsaber is part of the costume, it is allowed if it stays part of the costume and is not brandished about).
- Please send a bag labeled with the student's name for clothing and costume storage.
- Middle school students may wear their costumes for the duration of the day, as long as they do not distract from the learning in the classrooms. No masks or other costume head/face wear should be worn in classes.

### K-8 HALLOWEEN PARADE BEGINS AT 8:45AM

- The parking lot will close to traffic at 8:35am. All traffic arriving after that time will be routed onto the soccer field for parking.
- Parents can gather prior to the parade to enjoy coffee, cider, and donuts which will be set up near the main office entrance.
- Lenny Dale leads the costumed K-8 students outside from the library glass doors, down the steps, and around the Emerson parking lot.
- Parents can line up anywhere along the sidewalk or parking lot for optimal viewing and picture-taking--please spread out to ensure our parade will have supporters all along the route.
- In case of inclement weather, the parade will take place indoors. Lenny Dale will pick up students at their classrooms and lead them throughout the school. Best viewing for parents would be in the middle of the gym, in the library (Band & Orchestra will be performing there) or in other larger common areas.
