OVERVIEW

Emerson School Summer Camp at Allen Creek is seeking a full-time Summer Camp Assistant. We are searching for a talented, team-oriented candidate. This position reports directly to the Director of Auxiliary and Summer Programs. A degree in Early Childhood Education is required and the candidate must be at least 18 years old.

The Summer Camp Assistant responsibilities include overseeing the children and maintaining everyone's safety, and assisting the instructors throughout the day. Some days you might be helping to run an activity, other days you might be bringing a shy child into the group. Essentially, the Camp Assistant will be maintaining the well being of the campers. Based on the changing needs of the camps, the Camp Assistant might be asked to complete other tasks as needed. Before camp you'll greet parents and welcome the kids as they walk in, remind them to pick up their name tag, and have them choose a locker if they haven't done so already.

Emerson School Summer Camp at Allen Creek will run for 6 weeks beginning June 24, 2019 through August 9, 2019 from 9:15 am - 12:15 pm, Monday through Friday (with July 1-5 off in observance of Independence Holiday). Move-in/Orientation is June 21, 2019 at Allen Creek.
