OVERVIEW

Emerson School Summer is seeking Full-time and Part-time Summer Camp Counselors. We are searching for talented, team-oriented candidates. Each position reports directly to the Director of Auxiliary and Summer Programs. All candidates must be at least 18 years old.

Part-time Shift Options: 8:00 am - 1:00 pm or 12:00 pm - 6:00 pm

Responsibilities

The Summer Camp Counselor responsibilities include overseeing the children, maintaining everyone's safety, and assisting the instructors throughout the day. Some days you might be helping with an activity, and other days you might be bringing a shy child into the group. Essentially, the Summer Camp Counselor will be maintaining the well being of the campers.

Based on the changing needs of the various camps, the Summer Camp Counselor might be asked to complete other tasks as needed. Before camp you'll greet parents and welcome the kids as they walk in, remind campers to pick up their name tag, and have them choose a locker if they haven't done so already. Each morning and afternoon camp provides campers with a snack and juice. Snacks are served outside on the playground. With regard to lunch and recess, <u>all</u> campers are the Summer Camp Counselor's responsibility from 12:00 - 1:00 pm. Recess will take place from 12:20 pm - 1:00 pm

Emerson School Summer Camp will run for 7 weeks beginning the week of June 24, 2019 through the week of August 16, 2019 from 9:00 am - 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday. Move-in is June 17-19, 2019 (Orientation will be conducted during move-in).
