- <u>Casio</u> about \$15 (a more advanced calculator MAY be required in HS)

Don't:

- <u>Canon</u> or anything similar. Doesn't have all the functionality required.
- <u>TI Enspire</u> very advanced calculator lots of great functionality, BUT is banned from some HS/College classes and from standardized tests because it has internet access
