

# After School Program Winter Enrichment Classes

**JANUARY 13 - MARCH 20, 2020** 

Winter Enrichment Classes will run beginning the week of January 13th and ending March 20th with these exceptions: no classes Monday, January 20th (MLK DAY), no classes Thursday, February 13th (Mid-Winter Break), no classes Friday, February 14th (Mid-Winter Break), and no classes Monday, February 17th (Mid-Winter Break). Each class fee covers all associated costs and is billed to your account at the end of January. **Refunds are not given for missed classes or withdrawals**.

Classes are filled on a first come, first served basis. Please note the grade level requirements for each class; this will not be modified. Classes fill quickly, so you are urged to register as soon as possible. Classes that do not meet the minimum enrollment will be cancelled; you will be notified via email and your account will not be charged.

Students staying after school for enrichment classes will sign into the after school program in the library, we'll serve a snack, and then we'll get everyone to their class at the start time. When you arrive to pick up your child, park and come in the doors nearest the library to sign your child out with your PIN on the iPads. You aren't billed for child care during the time your child spends in his/her enrichment class, just any time he/she spends with us before and/or after the class.
