

Summer at Emerson is looking for a reliable, personable, and engaging instructor to teach chess camps for kindergarten through 2nd grade aged children as well as 3rd grade through 5th grade aged children. If you are passionate about chess, education, being a positive role model, and impacting young children, this position is the perfect fit for you!

These camps are meant to teach kids the fundamentals of chess while also focusing on character development. We want to give our campers the opportunity to develop their chess skills and enjoy playing the game while also learning how to be a good player and individual. Instructors will have the freedom to design their own weekly lesson plans regarding how they wish to structure their camps.

Summer at Emerson is an eight week long summer camp program that offers full day and half day camps from June 19th until August 18th (excluding the week of July 3-7). Half day camps take place during the morning portion of the camp day from 9am-12pm or during the afternoon portion from 1pm-4pm. Instructors must be available to teach for at least one full week during this eight week duration. We are happy to have you teach for as many weeks as you would like and are available for. Starting pay is \$525 per week per half day camp (3 hours/day Monday-Friday).

Each camp contains no more than 12-14 campers and will take place at Emerson School which is located at 5425 Scio Church Rd Ann Arbor, MI 48103. Each camp is allotted a budget for supplies that can be purchased and reimbursed for.
